Program / Department Summary

PADMANA (Program Pelatihan Laju Digital Meta Indonesia) is a digital MSMEs development program by Meta Indonesia, in partnership with Mercy Corps Indonesia. The digital marketing training on the PADMANA program will to support 250 MSMEs from 5 areas of MCI's intervention: Kabupaten Bandung, Kabupaten Garut, Kabupaten Malang, Kota Batu, and Kota Malang, to achieve economic independence through the digital channel provided by Meta Indonesia (Facebook, Instagram, Whatsapp), and Micromentor Indonesia. The program will also utilize Micromentor Indonesia's mentor network and hire 10 facilitators in 5 areas to ensure all participants understand the material and implement the knowledge from the training.
